


I. Early-Intervention Services (a partnership with the LPC Regional CMP):


School-Based Restorative Justice Services: 516 unduplicated youth served in 5 schools (+1 program: Phoenix) in the 9R School District in 2018-19 school year.

School-Based Behavioral Health Services: 166 youth enrolled in 2018-19 school year. Contracted therapists – 9; Schools participating – 9R District: 6 elementary, 3 middle, 3 high schools; MOU signed with Bayfield Middle School; Grief Group in Silverton School District (supported through LPCRCMP funds).

II. Intervention Services

Diversion Services Summary: 67 total intakes completed in fy19.





III. Robust-Collaborative Intervention Services (a partnership with the LPC Regional CMP): Radical Possibilities Mentorship: 12 youth and 9 mentors successfully participated in 2018-19 school year. No youth were expelled, or had charges filed while participating. Rate of school attendance increased by 33%.

Interagency Service and Support Team Meetings: 24 families, including 26 youth have participated in 34 meetings in the 2018-19 school year. Families with more than 1 meeting – 5.
